Non-exhaustive list of achievements made by the associations ADCS and Club Du Sahel

1. ADCS

The Association for the Development of Northern Cameroon (ADCS) is a non-profit organization that was founded in December 1994 in the Paris region by the nationals of the northern region of Cameroon residing in France in order to help meeting the needs in education and in health care which are crucial factors for the development and the strengthening of solidarity bonds amongst the citizens of the northern part of Cameroon.

The headquarters of ADCS Germany e.V. was established in 2003 in Germany and for reasons of tax systems, it's headquarter is based in the German city of Düsseldorf.

The headquarters of the ADCS in Paris is based at 30, avenue du Général de Gaulle 92250 La Garenne Colombes near Paris.

The resources of the association is for the time being based on only membership fees and membership dues and proceeds from events organized by the association.

Although based in France, the association has representatives in several regions of the world (including Cameroon) which brings together all members and supporters. In this regard, it should be noted that Northern Cameroon nationals residing in Germany have created ADCS Germany in October 2003 in Bonn. ADCS "Allemagne" also called ADCS Germany pursues the same objectives as ADCS France. Both associations have established a partnership, and active cooperation through joint projects and sharing of resources.

Since its creation, ADCS has completed the following works:

• 2009:

- Acquisition of 43 hospital beds with mattresses and some aprons from Viersen clinic in Germany and transportation funding to Douala.
- Reception and exit formalities at the customs of the container by the Club du Sahel
- Distribution of the beds was made as follows:
 - o Ngaoundéré's Protestant Hospital, Department of Vina, Adamawa Region
 - o Bogo's Hospital, Department of Diamaré, Far North Region
 - o Tcholliré's Hospital, Department of Mayo-Rey, Northern Region

• 2007:

- Financing the campaign against AIDS/HIV at the hospital of Pette (Department of Diamaré, Far North Province).

• 2005:

- Funding for the production of 50 desks for the Public School of Dargala (Department of Diamaré, Far North Province).
- Collection of forty computers and medical equipments to be shipped to the north.
- Publication of the newspaper "Le Septentrional". It is a collection which contains 150 pages of reflections in various fields such as education and health, culture, agriculture and livestock, economy,

environment, demography, sport and topics related to the development of the North and Cameroon in general. The authors identify the issues and recommend some solutions thanks to their capacity and proposal. About 1000 samples are available. Electronic version is also available.

- **2004:**

- Funding for the manufacture of 150 desks as follows:
 - o Delivery of 50 desks at Public School of Mayo-Darla (Department of Mayo-Banyo, Adamawa Province)
 - o Delivery of 50 desks at the Public School of Lam (Department of Mayo Louti, Northern Province)
 - o Delivery of 60 desks at the Public School of Ardaf (Department of Mayo-Danay, Province of the Far North)
- Donation of following medical equipments to the Provincial Hospital of Garoua (Northern Province): 10 adult medical beds, 1 pediatric bed, 5 bed rails, 3 mattresses, 3 wheel bedside cupboard, two mobile X-ray machines, 2 wheeled transfer cars for ambulance, 1 trolley for small care equipments, 5 operating tables, 5 medical examination tables with adjustable height, 1 gynecological examination table, 1 table for specialized examination, 1 operating microscope on foot, 1 sear apparatus, 2 centrifuges, 4 split lamps, 1 dome of Goldman, 1 Javal unit + small ophthalmic equipment, 2 light vision test tables, 2 scialytic lamps, 1 retinoscope, 2 electric pump-syringes, 1 oven, 7 electric hob, 1 hand-barrow, 7 drip holders, 3 splints cartons and American bands, 2 typewriters, various small equipments and accessories for operating theater and dozens of medical books.
- Donation of Computer Sciences equipments consisting of Compaq main Board CPU, a Compaq monitor and a Hewlett Packard color printer (HP Deskjet 695C) to the High School of Tignère (Department of Faro & Deo, the Adamawa Province)
- Donation of Computer Sciences equipments consisting of Compaq main Board CPU, a Compaq monitor and a Hewlett Packard color printer (HP Deskjet 695C) to the High School of Tcholliré (Department of Mayo-Rey, Northern Province)
- Donation of Computer Sciences equipments consisting of Compaq main Board CPU, a Compaq monitor and a Hewlett Packard color printer (HP Deskjet 695C) to High School students of Kaélé (Department of Mayo-Kani, Far North Province)
- Participation in the conference "Education in the north, Results and Prospects" held in Maroua in March 2004 by the "Club du Sahel", a sister organization based in Douala.

- **2002-2003:**

- Funding for the manufacture of 150 desks as follows:
 - o Delivery of 50 desks at the Public School of Dibi (Department of Vina, Adamawa Province)
 - o Delivery of 50 desks at the Public School of Bame (Department of Benue, Northern Province)
 - o Delivery of 50 desks at the Public School of Meri (Department of Diamaré, Province of the Far North)
- Donation of Computer Sciences equipments consisting of Compaq main Board CPU, a Compaq monitor and a Hewlett Packard color printer (HP Deskjet 695C) to the High School of Poli (Department of Faro, Northern Province)
- Donation a Hewlett Packard color printer (HP Deskjet 695C) to the High School of Ngaoundéré-Mardock (Department of Vina, Adamawa Province)

- A grant of 100,000 F CFA to “Espoir Médical du Septentrion” (EMS), friendly grouping of medical students from Northern Cameroon. This grant corresponds to the contribution of the ADCS to the health campaign undertaken by EMS in Northern Cameroon in July 2003

• 2001:

- Sending of 21 electronic typewriters and a Computer with a dot matrix printer. These machines and computers were received in Douala by the “Club du Sahel” (an association of citizens of the northern part of Cameroon) who has forwarded them to secondary schools in Northern Cameroon.

• 2000:

- Sending of 4 Mac Intosh Computer, hence 2 to the University of Ngaoundéré (Adamawa Province), the other 2 being kept in Yaoundé and Douala for students residing in these two cities to help them writing their reports, theses ... etc..

• 1999:

- Sending of 4000 textbooks (For class 6 to class 13) to public secondary schools in Garoua (Northern Province) and 1500 novels of general culture in the library of Garoua.

• 1997:

- Sending of 20 kg of generics Health Medicines to the Health Centre of Mémé (Far North Province).

It is in this context that ADCS is trying to contribute in both physical and intellectual (through participation in conferences and publications) in the development of education and health system as key factors for general development. Hence our association has decided to launch Maroua symposium in 2012.
